

Ancient Egypt Project Guide

You will be responsible for researching a topic of your choice relating to our studies of ancient Egypt. Your final project should be done in an original, creative, eye-catching format.

Your project will consist of the following parts:

- A physical, handmade project relating to your topic.
- A written description relating to your topic.
- At least three note cards containing the different resources used for researching your topic (bibliography resources – need three).

Possible categories from which to choose a topic include:

- Government – includes pharaohs, crowns, monuments built
- Writing System – includes how they wrote, how we discovered their language, where it was used, who did the writing
- Nile River – includes uses and importance, geography, location
- Burial Customs – includes mummification, use of pyramids, afterlife
- Everyday life – includes clothing, food, games, toys, tools
- Gods and Goddesses – includes who they worshipped and how
- Pyramids – includes their purpose, how they were built
- King “Tut” Tutankhamen – Includes his life, his tomb, “the curse”

Below are some suggestions for your final project:

- Create a display on a tri-fold board or poster board
- Create a scrapbook with fascination facts and pictures
- Create a mobile
- Create a diorama
- Make a game
- Create an exhibit for a museum
- Come up with your own original design

Although there will be some research time provided, this project will be done almost entirely outside of class.
