

# Storybook Project Guide

Storybooks tell wonderful tales. Choose your favorite storybook and create a scene from your favorite part of the story, or make up a nice new part of the story using your imagination and create a scene from your imagination.

Your project needs to include these important factors:

- Project information (in any order): your name, the project title, teacher's and class name and the date
- A handmade project relating to your storybook
- A book report on your storybook
- Talk to (interview) three grownups who have read your story and write a few sentences about what they said about the story

Some stories you can choose from, or choose your own favorite:

- Cinderella
- Jack And The Beanstalk
- Hercules
- Rapunzel and her spinning wheel
- Snow White
- Mowgli in the Jungle Book

Below are some suggestions for your final project:

- Create a display on a tri-fold board or poster board
- Create a scrapbook with facts and pictures
- Create a mobile
- Create a diorama
- Make a game
- Create an exhibit for a museum
- Come up with your own original design
