

- Paint Pine Trees

- Dip tips of a flat paintbrush in paint. Hold brush bristles vertical and lightly dab tips of brush to create a trunk. Dip brush in paint and water as needed.
- Next, hold brush bristles horizontal. Starting at the top of the tree, lightly dab paint with tips of brush to create leaves. (See inset picture for brush stroke.)
- In a triangular pattern, continue dabbing paint until tree is complete.



- Paint Palm Trees

- Paint outline of trunk. Dip brush in paint as needed.
- Dip tips of a flat paintbrush in paint. Holding bristles of brush horizontally, dab and push paintbrush along trunk. Move brush in one direction, either up or down. This will create the unique texture of a palm trunk.
- For leaves, paint a single downward stroke for top of leaf. Then, holding bristle of brush horizontally, make short strokes for bottom of leaf.
- Add additional leaves in a circular pattern. Paint coconuts, if desired.
