

## - Light Snow Dusting

Give trees and ground cover a very light dusting of snow.

- Spray area with diluted Project Glue.
- Sprinkle Snowflakes while glue is wet.
- Spray with diluted Project Glue to seal. (See Project Glue pg. 170)



## - Backdrop Snow

Make your backdrop scene three-dimensional with Backdrop Snow.

- Mix equal amounts of Project Glue and Snow Base.
- Slowly mix in Snowflakes until desired consistency has been achieved.
- Dab snow mixture on desired location.
- Sprinkle additional Snowflakes on top of wet snow mixture.



## - Make a Frozen Pond

Create a realistic snow covered pond.

- Prepare and paint a water area. (See Water Areas pg. 161)
- Pour Realistic Water slowly onto dried water area.
- While Realistic Water is wet, lightly sprinkle Snowflakes.
- Let dry 24 hours.



## - Add Snow to Trees

- Dab Snow Mixture on trees, working from top to bottom. Sprinkle with Snowflakes while mixture is wet.
- Sprinkle additional Snowflakes on tree while Snow Mixture is wet.

**TIP!** When painting glaciers, dab light blue Project Paint randomly over Snow Base for a more "icy" look.
