


- Stone Pattern

- Using a pencil, draw a stone-shape pattern. The pencil markings represent cement or mortar. Use this technique on Project Board, Construction Board or a ReadyGrass Sheet.

OPTION: Make indentations into Project Board by pressing with a blunt instrument.

Painting Suggestion: A Color Wash allows the stone pattern to remain visible through the paint.



- Lap Siding

- Using a pencil and ruler, draw horizontal lines on Project Board.
- Score by cutting along horizontal lines. Cut through the top layer of paper and the foam only.
- Push down at an angle along top of score marks with the end of a ruler.

Painting Suggestion: Paint the lap siding with horizontal brush strokes.



- Log Pattern

- Using a pencil and ruler, draw horizontal lines on Project Board.
- Score by cutting along horizontal lines. Cut through the top layer of paper and the foam only.
- Using the dull end of a paintbrush, indent along score lines.

Painting Suggestion: Make sure to get the paint into all the crevices in the log pattern.
