

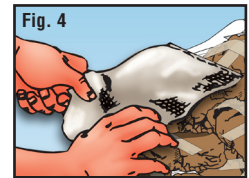
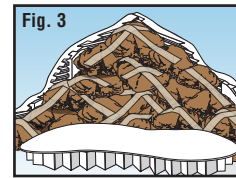
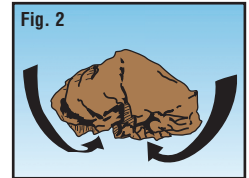
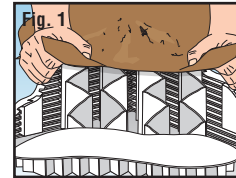
NO-NEWS PAPER™ - C1188



INSTRUCTIONS

Use No-News Paper to build terrain and substructure in preparation for a plaster shell. No-News Paper is heavier than newspaper, offering more support and requiring less paper when making wads. It also keeps your hands clean, and is convenient to store.

1. Pull No-News Paper out of dispenser box to desired length. Hold lid closed and tear downward along tearing edge.
2. Create terrain base in desired manner.
 - a. Install and shape Support Panels (C1172, C1173) into desired terrain formation. Scrunch a sheet of No-News Paper to give it flexibility, then form it over Support Panels (**Fig. 1**). Paper should be slightly larger than project area. Attach to Support Panels with Sticky Spots™ (C1167) or Low Temp Foam Glue (ST1445, ST1446). Tack a second scrunched layer of No-News Paper on top of the first layer. Trim away excess Paper.
 - b. Create pillow-shaped wads by rolling edges under in a circular motion (**Fig. 2**). Stack wads to form desired terrain shape and hold in place with masking tape (**Fig. 3**).
3. Apply Plaster Cloth (C1191-C1193, C1203) over No-News Paper to create a hard-shell (**Fig. 4**).
