

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Micro Sticky Spots (Fig. 1)

1. How to Apply Sticky Spots to Paper: Press a Sticky Spot onto the area marked with • and lift off the backing paper.

## Prepare Parts

- 1. All cutouts that are printed on the cardstock are pre-cut. Punch out each component along the precut solid lines.
- 2. Keep parts for each different cutout together.
- NOTE: Some cutouts have labels on the back for reference.

### Large Pyramid (Fig. 2 and 3)

**NOTES:** The triangles will be placed in an alternating order of triangles and inverted triangles (V-shape). When placing one triangle on top of the other, the visible tab that will be covered should be the right or upper right tab depending on the direction of the triangle. The tabbed side of a triangle is always attached under an untabbed side (Fig. 2). See the backside of the Large Pyramid's parts for reference labels.

- 1. Fold all score lines backwards.
- 2. Apply Sticky Spots to the markings on (1A).
- 3. The next triangle should be placed so that it is an inverted triangle. (1B) is labeled on the back of the triangle that has (2A) labeled on its front. Attach (1B) to (1A), aligning (1B) so it is even with (1A)'s tab line. Press into place.
- 4. When constructing the Pyramid, attach pieces in a counter-clockwise rotation. Apply Sticky Spots to the markings on (2A). Attach (2B) to (2A) and press into place.
- 5. Apply Sticky Spots to the markings on (3A). The triangle that (3B) is on is an inverted triangle. Attach (3B) to (3A), pressing Sticky Spots into place.
- 6. Fold (4A) inwards. Apply Sticky Spots to the markings on (4A). Attach (4B) to (4A) and press into place. (Fig. 3)

### Medium Pyramid (Fig. 3)

- 1. Fold all score lines. Apply Sticky Spots to the markings on (5A).
- 2. Attach (5B) to (5A), aligning (5B) so it is even with (5A)'s tab line. Press into place.

## Small Pyramid (Fig. 3)

- 1. Fold all score lines. Apply Sticky Spots to the markings on (6A).
- 2. Attach (6B) to (6A), aligning (6B) so it is even with (6A)'s tab line. Press into place.

## Cutaway Pyramid (Fig. 4, 5 and 6)

- Fold the center score line of the triangle with the inner chamber inwards. Fold the side pieces outwards on the score lines. Tabs get folded away from the front.
- 2. Fold the three tabs of the second Wall piece backwards. Fold the Base on the scored line. (Fig. 4)
- Fold (7B) backwards. Apply Sticky Spots to the • markings on (7B) and press into place under (7A).
- Fold (7C) backwards. Apply Sticky Spots to the • markings on (7C) and press into place under (7D).
- 5. Fold (7F) backwards. Apply Sticky Spots to the • markings on (7F) and press into place under (7E). (Fig. 5)
- Fold tabs (7F)–(7J) over the Base of the Pyramid. Apply Sticky Spots to the • markings on the base of the Pyramid. Press tabs (7F)–(7J) into place over the Sticky Spots. When finished, the tabs should be visible. (Fig. 5 and 6)

**NOTE:** If desired, place the Inner Chamber Legend on the backdrop of the scene.

#### Boat (Fig. 7, 8, 9 and 10)

- 1. Fold on the score line. Curl the ends of the Boat (the bow and the stern) upwards. Bend the four end tabs upwards. (Fig. 7)
- NOTE: The turquoise line should be on the outside of the Boat.
- 2. Fold the tip of the end into an inverted V-shape. Line up the side with the end, following the contour of the Boat. Repeat this step for the other end of the Boat. See illustration for details (Fig. 8).
- NOTE: For easier folding, use a straightedge.
- 3. Apply Sticky Spots to the markings on each tab at each end of the Boat. Align the bottom of the Boat with the sides of the Boat.
- 4. Wrap one Sticky Spot over the inverted V tip at the end of the Boat. Repeat this step for the other inverted V tip of the Boat. (Fig. 9)
- 5. Apply Sticky Spots to the markings on the left and right curved ends of the Boat. Press into place. Repeat this step for the other end of the Boat. (Fig. 10)
